## 1. PREPARATION

- **Questions.** In the **Questions** section, you can select questions from the classroom **Question bank** and assign them in the exam.

The number of exam variations you have configured (Groups) is displayed, and you can assign questions to each template - either the same questions in a different order, or either different questions altogether.

- **Forms.** In **Forms** you can preview the exam (and make modifications if needed).

You can also generate (and download) the documents associated with the exam:

- **Question form** (template document with the questions and the given answer choices).
- **Answer form** (template where the student will mark his/her answers).
- **Correction form** (exam questions indicating which answer(s) are corrected in each case).

## 2. EVALUATION

- **Upload.** In the **Upload** section, you will upload a .zip file containing all the scanned student answer sheets.

You will also see the status of the upload process.

- **Results.** In the **Results** section, you can see how many exams were automatically graded without error and how many returned some type of error (NIU reading error, incorrect answers, or errors in the scanned document's reference marks).

If you encounter an error, you can correct it in this section.

### 3. STATISTICS

- Quiz information.
- Question analysis.

At any time, you can see which phases or actions have been completed and which require your attention. An informative legend is provided below the activity overview for your convenience.

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
